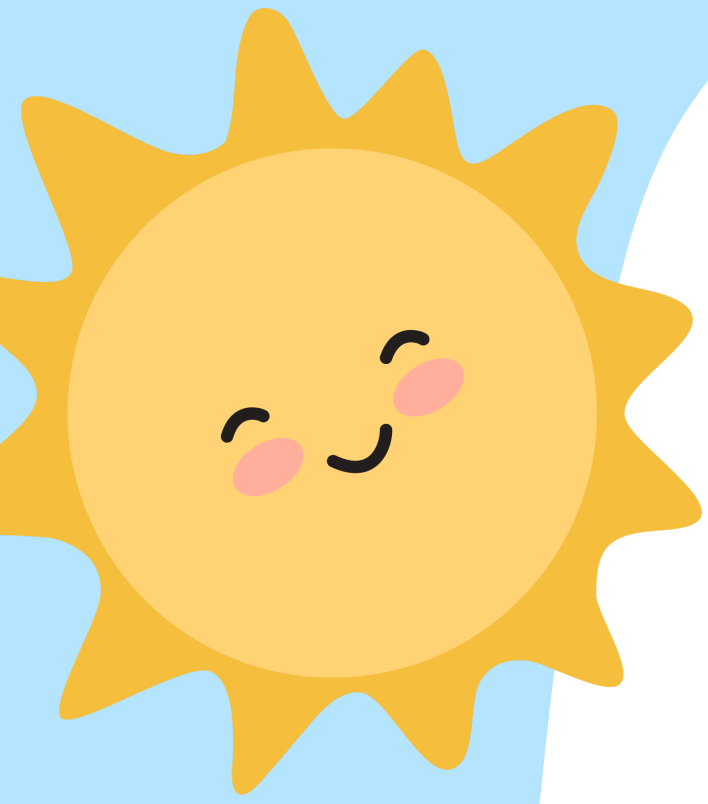

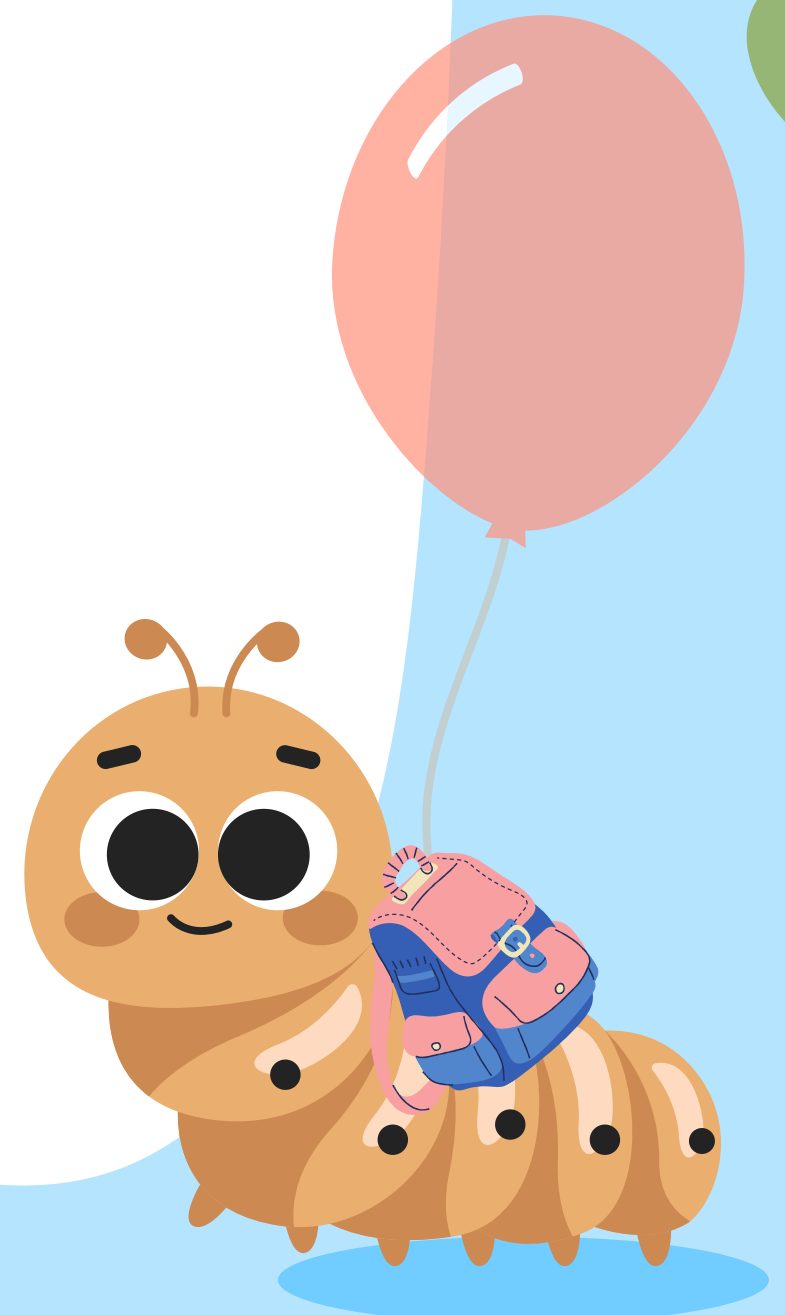

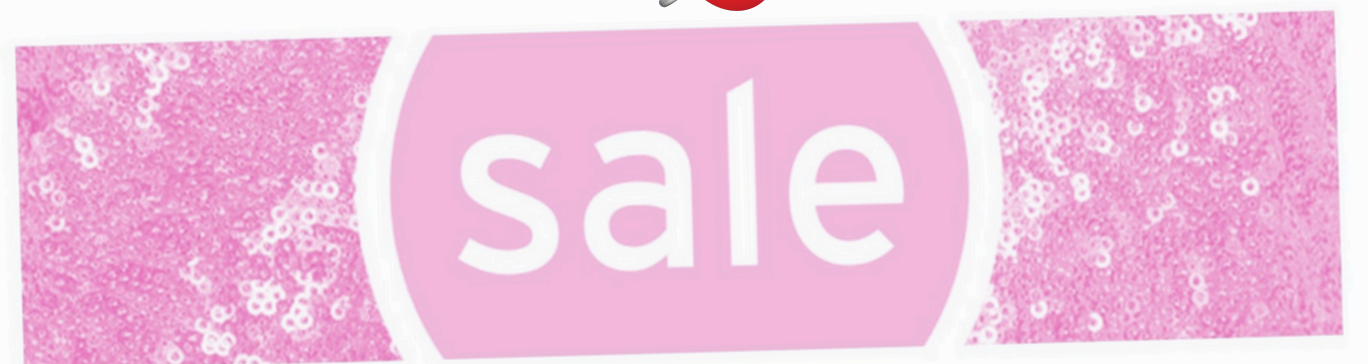
Flu Vaccine Clinic

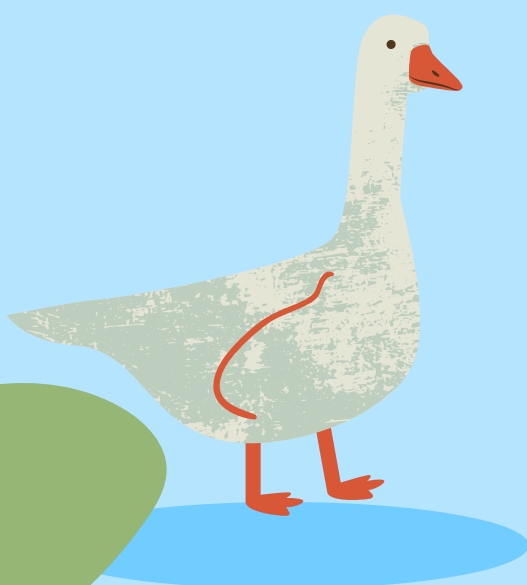
